Ordered therefore that the s^d James Stavely and other the Compl^{ts} above named and every of them (all excuses sett apart) be and personally appeare before his L^{spp} and Councill at the City of S^t Maries in the time of the next Provinciall Court to make good the charge by them exhibited against the s^d Inglish, and also that the said Inglish be likewise there personally present to answer and make his Defence thereunto. Whereof they are not to faile at their perill Dated at the said City of S^t Maries the Eighth Day of October in the Sixth yeare of the Dominion of the R^t hon^{ble} Charles &c^a Annoq Domini 1681: Signed p ord^r
