Taillor & Burges acc^{ts} Ex^d

Came M^r Thomas Burford Atto^rney for Coll Thomas Taillor and M^r Kenelm Cheseldine Atto^rney for Coll W^m Burges admitted, and proceed to argue the particulars of said Taillors acco^t brought ag^t s^d Burges, and beginn with the second Article D^r 16000^l tob^o

Which Article Coll Burges objects ag^t and alledges that Coll Taillor hath been satisfied the same as did appeare to his L^{sp} before he went for England, and he doubts not but some of his L^{sps} acc^{ts} if to be produced would make it appeare.

Coll Darnall is desired to make inspection unto all his L^{sps} bookes of Acc^{ts} whither any such thing be there to be found in favour of the said Burges.

His L^{spps} booke of acc^{ts} N^o 2 is produced wherein George Burges late Sheriff of Anne Arrundell County hath creditt upon his acco^t for the just summe of 16000^l tob^o by a note drawne on him pay^a to Coll Taillor which is thought to be in discharge of the 2^d Article of this acc^t.

Coll Taillor called and hath shewn unto him the said George Burges acc^t in his L^{sps} s^d Booke, To which for answer he saith that that Article of 16000^l tob^o for w^{ch} Burges hath Creditt as p^d to him s^d Taylor may be for some other concernes betweene his L^{sp} & him whereof at p^rsent (not haveing his bookes here) he cannot exactly give an account; but insists that he has made oath to his acc^t now exhibited ag^t s^d Burges, and hopes it may be allowed of, and further to confirme the same prays the rehearing of the severall Depositions of James Ellis, Sarah Willowby and Walter Carr w^{ch} were accordingly read.

Maj^r Nicholas Sewall desired to declare what he knoweth of the difference betweene Coll Taillor & Coll Burges, in their acc^{ts} and what he might have heard his L^{sp} say concerning the same; He upon oath saith that to the best of his knowledge and he doth verily think he heard his L^{sp} say before his Departure for England that Coll Taillor told him he had taken a Bond from ffrancklyn for the ball. of his acco^t but would not lett Burges know of it. p. 316
