Whereas Samuel ffendall and Thomas Humphryes of Charles County stand charged with and accused of divers mutinous and seditious speeches practices and attempts against his L<sup>spps</sup> peace and Governm<sup>t</sup> Ordered therefore that Majo<sup>r</sup> William Boareman high Sheriff of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County or his Deputy Receive of Cap<sup>t</sup> L<sup>t</sup> Michael Ashford and take into his custody the bodys of the said Samuel ffendall and Thomas Humphryes, and them safely keepe soe that he have them before his L<sup>spps</sup> Justices of the Provinciall Court at the next Provinciall Court to be holden at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Maries. Whereof he is not to faile at his perill. Dated the thirteenth Day of October in the Sixth year of the Dominion of the R<sup>t</sup> hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles &c<sup>a</sup> Annoq Domini 1681:
