

Liber R. At a Council held at the house of the hon<sup>ble</sup> Philip Calvert  
 p. 293 Esq<sup>r</sup> the 23<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1681:

The Right hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>ry</sup>  
 The hon<sup>ble</sup> { Philip Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Chancelo<sup>r</sup> } Present

At which time came Thomas Wynn of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County by his L<sup>dsp</sup>s appointm<sup>t</sup> and tendred his Acco<sup>t</sup> of charges on George Godfreys guard dureing the time of his Imprisonm<sup>t</sup> to this Day upon which was allowed him the summe of five Thousand four hundred and ffifty pounds of tobacco. 5450

Came James Pattison also by the same appointm<sup>t</sup> and exhibited his Acco<sup>t</sup> for charges of George Godfreys Imprisonm<sup>t</sup> and accommodacōn at his house which was modelled and thereupon allowed four thousand pounds of tobacco } 4000

William Gwyther also according to appointm<sup>t</sup> came and exhibited his Acco<sup>t</sup> of charges for Imprisonm<sup>t</sup> guard and accommodacōns of Capt. Josias ffendall at his house upon w<sup>ch</sup> was allowed five thousand One hundred and Sixty pounds of tobacco } 5160

Walter Lane of Sommersett County craved allowance of four hundred and One pounds of tobacco according to his Acco<sup>t</sup> exhibited for the hyre of a shallop to fetch John Bright and his wife (Evidences against ffendall) from the Eastern shore, for provisions for them and his owne wages he charges and is allowed } 401

Ordered that George Godfrey be removed from M<sup>r</sup> Pattisons house and committed into the custody of the Sheriff of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County there to remaine close Prisoner in Irons till further order from his L<sup>dsp</sup> according to the following precept

Mary<sup>ld</sup> ss:

You have herewith sent you the body of George Godfrey lately condemned to dye for mutinous and seditious speeches practices and attempts with force against his L<sup>dsp</sup> and Governm<sup>t</sup> you are therefore hereby required to take him into your care and charge, and in safe custody keepe him bound in Iron untill such time as you shall receive further ord<sup>rs</sup> from his L<sup>dsp</sup> concerning him whereof you are not to faile at your perill. And for soe doing this shall be your warrant. Dated the three and Twentyeth day of November in the sixth yeare of
