The Chancelo^r is Desired to Command the Clk of the Councill John Llewelin to draw warrant for the apprehending Thomas Marshall of Charles County to appeare the first day the next Prov^l Court afore the Councill also summons for John Bracher, John Pembroke, Philip Coomes, by the above Letter, there is mention made of two persons * John Brooke one should be named John Bracher* but for the certainty thereof the Chancelo^r may send to S^t Johns for Diermott To M^r George Buttler. Wherevpon issued these following precepts to the Sheriff of Charles County viz.

Maryland ss:

Whereas Thomas Marshall of Charles County hath lately uttered and spoken diverse scandalous mutinous and seditious speeches ag^t his L^{dsp} the R^t hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ry} of this Province tending not onely to the breach of his L^{dsp}s peace and the disturbance of the Quiett Rule and Governm^t of this Province, but also to the takeing away the life of his said L^{dsp} and others of his hon^{ble} Councill as to his L^{dsp} hath been informed and sett forth.

You are therefore hereby willed and Required as also strictly charged & Comanded immediately upon sight hereof to apprehend and take into your custody the body of the s^d Thomas Marshall and him safely keepe, soe that you have him before his L^{dsp} and Councill at the City of S^t Maries on Tuesday next the 28th instant to answer the premisses: Whereof faile not and for soe doeing this shall be your warrant Given at the s^d City of S^t Maries the 23th Day of ffebruary in the Seaventh yeare of the Dominion of the R^t hon^{ble} Charles &c^a Annoq Dmi 1681:
