The first and last day of the Provinciall Court appointed by his L<sup>dsp</sup> for Councill day touching lands notice whereof to be given by an order of this board to be affixed to the Court house doore for that purpose, w<sup>ch</sup> accordingly issued viz.

The first and last day of this Provinciall Court his L<sup>dsp</sup> hath appointed to sitt in Councill at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Maries to heare and receive all addresses to him made concerning Lands, whereof all persons concerned are to take cognizance soe as to be there personally present themselves or have their Attorney there ready to state their Case for his L<sup>dsp</sup> and Councills better Information, without which his L<sup>dsp</sup> will heare noe Petitions of that nature.
