You are also on Monday following to visitt Majo^r Boareman and his Company at the usuall and appointed place of Rendevouz for musters and traineing he haveing reed: the like ord^{rs} from me to be in a readiness there to meete you, a list of the men inlisted under him you are also to take and an Acco^t of their Armes belonging also to the Magazine which you must cause to be lodged at the Majo^{rs} house to the end and purpose afores^d Whereof faile not and for soe doeing this shall sufficiently Empower you. Given under my hand this fourteenth Day of March Anno Dmi 1681:

These are to Authorise and Empower the bearer hereof Mr Thomas Owsley as Agent to and for and in behalf of Coll Cadwallader Jones of the Collony of Virginia to trade traffick and deale with any the Nantecoke Indians for Roanoke or Peake, giveing in barter for the same any European or other Commodityes whatsoever (powder, shott, and armes onely excepted) for all w^{ch} this shall be his sufficient warrant. Given under our hand and Seale at Armes the fourteenth day of March in the Seaventh yeare of our Dominion &c^a Annoq Dmi 1681:

This lycense to endure for six moneths from the date hereof.
