The humble Petition of James Ringold Sheweth

That the Com^{rs} of the s^d County about two yeares since did allow out of the County Leavy unto Richard Swettnam £4000 of Tobacco, £1538 part thereof the s^d Sweatnam did by a note under his hand ord^r Michael Miller then and still Sheriff of the s^d County to pay to the Petitioner, which s^d summe the s^d Miller hath not yett paid much to the Damage of yo^r Petitioner, & contrary to the trust reposed in him as Sheriffe p. 316

The premisses considered the Pet^r humbly begs that the s^d Sheriffe may answer the premisses, and that such ord^r may be taken therein as to y^r L^d^{shipp} shall seeme meete.
