Proclama- tion declare- ing the Assembly dissolved Whereas the Generall Assembly of this Province begun and held at the City of S^t Maries the Tenth day of May Anno Domini 1692 by Writ from his Ex^{ncie} the late Governo^r Lionel Copley Esq dec^d hath been by severall Prorogations & adjournm^{ts} continued to the 20th day of this instant September: And the Chiefe Command & Governm^t of this Province being now divolved vpon me S^r Edmond Andros Kn^t by the death of the said Lionel Copley and the absence of Captain ffrancis Nicholson their Maj^{ties} Lievetenant Governo^r of this Province, by their Maj^{ties} Royall Comission to me directed for that purpose: I doe by & with the advice of their Maj^{ties} Councill of this Province, Proclame, publish and make knowne that the said Generall Assembly is dissolved, and the same is hereby in their Maj^{ties} Names declared and pronounced accordingly to be dissolved, whereof I doe straightly Charge & Comānd all & singular the respective Sherriffes of the severall & respective Counties of this Province to make publick Proclamation in the most publick & convenient places within their respective Counties afores^d for the General Information of all & singular their Maj^{ties} loveing Subjects within this Province, and to the End that all persons concerned may take due Notice thereof & conforme themselves accordingly. p. 7

Given at the City of S^t Maries the 26th day of September Anno Domini 1693 in the fffith yeare of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord & Lady King William and Queen Mary.
