Whitehall Acco^t of Amunicōn & Armes at St Maries
 Produced at the Board an Acco^t taken by the Hono^{ble} Coll Nicho^{as} Greenberry October the 16th 1692 of all the publick Armes & Amunicōn then Lodged at St Maries as likewise another Acco^t by the Hono^{ble} Sr Tho: Laurence Barron^t 26th of June After w^{ch} are as follows Octob^r the 16th day 1693 I took an Acco^t of all the publick Arms and Amunicōn Lodged at St Maries City & are as followeth Viz^t
