And further Ordered that the ffield Officers aforemenconed call for an Exact Accor of all the publick Armes in the Sev'll Counties and that they dispose of the Same to such places as they shall see fit for Securing the ffronteers and to see that the same be well fixed wth all possible Expedition, And such as cannot be fixed here that care be taken by the ffield Officers to send the Same for England if they be will Sending to be fixed there and that all persons supplye themselves wth Armes

and Amunicon pursuant to the Act of this Province.

That the ffield Officers take care to change as much powder as they see convenient and Order the Officers under them tht have the Charge of any powder for to looke well after it and turne it at the least once A Month.
