This Board doe Agree with the Vote of the s<sup>d</sup> House, and all the Lawyers in Town appearing at the Board to Advize whether the Law will admit of Bayle in Such Case, and whether an Act for the s<sup>d</sup> Purpose might be proper to pass; To which they are of Opinion that they may be set to Bayle upon Soe Speciall a Case as this and that the Same will be best to be Done without an Act Then it is Demanded by his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> what Bayle is most proper to be taken, to which was answered that the best way that Can be taken is that they bring two persons who will Enter into Recognizance body for Body that the s<sup>d</sup> Prison<sup>rs</sup> shall be forth Coming when Called.

Ordered that the s<sup>d</sup> Prison<sup>rs</sup> be set to Bayle they bringing two persons to morrow morning before this Board and House of Burgesses that will enter into Recognizance body for Body for the s<sup>d</sup> Mason and Burley's appearance when Called.
