Ordr about Ordered that An Order of his Excency and Coun-Susannah Dryers Oath cill bearing Date the sixth day of May Anno 1693 relating to the invalidating the Oath of one Susanah Dryer Wife to Sam¹¹ Dryer of An-Arundell County be totally and for ever set Asside disanulled and made Voyd so that by means of any thing in the Sd Order contained she be nowise rendered incapable of haveing her Oath taken in any Court or before any Justice wthin this province
