The Hono<sup>ble</sup> Edward Randolph Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyo<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>ll</sup> of their Majesties Customs &ca acquainting his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> with his designe of going shortly to New York, his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> therevpon was pleased to give his directions for the said M<sup>r</sup> Randolphs inquiring into M<sup>r</sup> Miles fforsters Charge to the late Governor Copley about Arms & Amunition shipped by the said fforster in New York, in and vpon the Sloope called the Johannis, John Trevet, Master Copyy of which Charge attested by his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> and Originall Bill of loading signed by said Trevet he the said M<sup>r</sup> Randolph Received from <sup>p. 109</sup> his Excellency for the said End & purpose; Ordered that the said M<sup>r</sup> Randolph make inquiry (pursuant to former Order of his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> of the 9<sup>th</sup> of October last past) whether the Custom Charged by M<sup>r</sup> fforster to Governo<sup>r</sup> Copleys Acco<sup>t</sup> should not be Refunded being the Kings Stores; And that as to the Eight Barrells of fine powder remaining still in the said M<sup>r</sup> fforsters hands, the said M<sup>r</sup> Randolph is likewise Ordered to take care when he comes to New York, for to get the same shipped hither, if he meets with a convenient oportunity to do the same at an easy
