Mats Lettr Trusty & well beloved We Greet you Well Abt assistance to New Whereas it hath been Represented unto Us that not wthstanding the Significacon of our pleasure to our Severall Collonies and Provinces in the Northern Parts of America, the 11th day of October 1692: to be aiding and assisting to Our Govern or Command in Cheif of our Province of New Yorke for the Defence and Security of our sd Province agt the Attempts of our Enemies, And to agree upon a Quota of Men or other Assistants to be given by each of our said Colonies or Provinces for the Defence & security of our said Province of New York some of our said Colonies or Provinces haveing Omitted to send Comissioners to Adjust the Quotas to be furnished by them respectively, nothing hath been done therein We have thereupon thought fit to Appoint the severall Quota's of Men or other Assistance to be furnish'd by our said Colonies and Provinces respectively for the Defence and Security of our said Province of New
