Anoq Dni 1695.

The Condition of this Obligacōn is Such that Whereas the above bound Edward Green hath by his humble petition to his s^d Ex^{cy} ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r in Councill humbly sett forth that liveing Convenient to the Sea bord side in Sumersett County & owning most part of the Marshes, Sand banks and breakers of the maine Sea so farr as the Limitts of the said County Extends therefore prayd a Comission might be given him for the Seizing all Wrecks thither Comeing & Condemn- able as also to look after all Whales & other Royall fish which at Any time may happen to be driven and Call up there with Liberty of Trying Oyle what Can be gott of the bluber of the Same which being granted it is hereby provided that if the
