Know all men by these p^rsents that we Thomas Collier, p. 213
Henry Jowles Esq^r and ffrancis Collier are holden and firmly bound unto his Ex^{cy} ffrancis Nicholson Esq. his Matys Cap^t gen^{ll} and Chiefe Gov^r of this Province in the full and Just Sum^e of one Thousand pounds of Lawfull money of England to be payd to the said ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r his heires Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} or Assignes to the which paym^t well and truly to be made we bind our Selves and either of us by himselfe our and Either of our heires Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs} Jointly and Sev^rally for the whole and in the whole firmly by these p^rsents Witness our hands & Seales this 22^d day of August Annoq Dni 1695.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that Whereas his Ex^{cy} ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r afores^d hath Comissionated and Appointed the s^d Thomas Collier to be Navall Officer for the Port of W^mStadt and Rideing Surveyor within all Limits and p^rcincts of the five Countyes lying on the Eastern shoar within the s^d Province by his Comission bearing equall Date with these p^rsents. Now if the said Thomas Collier shall well and truly p^rforme his Duty in the Managem^t of the two said Offices according to the Laws of England and shall observe the sev^rall Acts of Assembly of this Province and the directions Sett down in two Certeine Proclamations bearing Dates the 17th day of August Instant touching the Trade of Pensilvania and the other bearing Date the Twentieth of the s^d month relateing to the Gauge of Tobbacco hhds &c. and from time to time Save defend and Keep harmless the said ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r from all Damages Loss and Charges that he the s^d ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r shall Susteine att any time by reason of the s^d Colliers non p^rformance of the s^d Offices so long as he shall enjoy the Same as in the said Severall Laws
