You shall not be of Councill or give Councill with any ag^t his Majesty or whereby his Dues or profits may be lessened or diminished, but in all things according to the best of your skill & power well and truly serve his said Majesty in the s^d Office while you shall continue therein, and to see all Criminalls duly prosecuted
