The Govern' of Canida hath alwayes desired to speake of peace with the ffive Nations and that he would come so farr as to Cadaracqui, but now We see it is a false design, for now We bring a token from the ffive Nations whereby We acquaint your Excell that it is certain that the Govern of Canida hath kindled his fire at Cadaracqui again and is busy to Repair the Walls; Now I speak from Dekanitsore Captain of the Onondages who desires the thirty Soldiers that were promised to him formerly to lye in Garrison at Onondage, do give a belt of Wampum, 16 deep.
