Lib. H. D. there, may redound more to the benefit of the Estate, which would otherwise be chargeable to remove to this side; besides the same perhaps now lyes in a perishable condition.

> Esqr Tench's Vpon Motion made by Thomas Tench Esqr that Motion & the Guns and Antient in Capt Meech's Sloop were Ordr for Guns &ca on by him lent vnto the sd Meech, and that they will be Board Capt wanted in the new Vessell, belonging to Mr Davy, Meech's now bound for England; saying that the Guns lent were two third iron guns & two third brass guns together with a Muskatoon, which he desires may be left out of the Appraisem of the other Goods, and that they may be brought & put on shore at M' Philip Clarkes, at Piney Point, for the aforementioned Vessell to take in; Ordered that the Motion of the sd Esqr Tench be granted accordingly.
