He is asked if he was a board the aforementioned ship, who does say he was; in the next place his Ex^{ncy} askes him whether he knew that Cap^t Meech had a Commission to looke after illegall Traders, who says that he did by Report hear such a thing; Ordered that the said Hebb be taken into custody & Carryed before the Justices of the provinciall Court, now sitting together with the Depositions & papers for their Examination, and that he be prosecuted & proceeded against according to Law.
