Ord^r touching the Vestry's, what inside Worke they are obliged to perform in their Churches Vpon Representation, Ordered that the Vestrymen of the severall and respective Parishcs within this Province be obliged to perform & see finished, within their respective parish Churches, no other inside worke than Viz^t plastering the Walls, making the pulpit, the Reading pew & Clerks Desk, to provide a Communion table & Raile in the same; And as for all other pews & seats, that the severall Parishioners be at charge of making the same according to their own liking. And it is hereby further ordered that the Sheriffs of the Province give Copy of this Order to the severall Vestrys within their respective Precincts.
