Ordered th^t noe Person pay any greater Value, for the Lots laid out at Williamstadt than what the Same were by the late Jury Appraised at; nor that the motion made, by M^r Nicholas Lowe in the House of Burgesses in Relation to the Agreem^t made ab^t the Town Common for 12000^{lbs} of Tob^o be in the least taken notice of; notwithstanding any Ord^r Vote or Result of the House therein, there appearing no Assent of his Ex^{ncy} or Coun- cill to Confirm the Same.
