Ordered that the Sherriffes of the Province forth-  
with give Notice to the Severall County Justices and  
Vestrymen within their Repective precincts that the  
s<sup>d</sup> Justices and Vestrymen take Care to make and  
Cause to be made Strict inquiry in all parts of their  
respective County's and parishes what persons have been mar-  
ryed by Lycenses Since his Ex<sup>ncies</sup> arrivall in this province, and  
who have marryed without Lycenses &c<sup>a</sup> or asked to Church;  
And that the s<sup>d</sup> Acco<sup>t</sup> be given to the Severall Vestry and  
County Clerks who are to make an Exact List there of & Return  
the Same unto his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> at the port of Annapolis by the 29<sup>th</sup>  
day of September next, under penalty of being proceeded ag<sup>t</sup>  
for Contempt.

Ord<sup>r</sup> to the  
Colonels of  
the ffrontier  
County's

Ordered that the Colonels of Ann Arrundell, Prince  
Georges, Baltemore & Cæcill Counties (being ffrontier  
County's) have their Severall Troops and Com-  
panies always in a Readiness with their Arms well fixed (upon  
any occasion which may happen) and upon discovery by any  
person of either fFrench or fforreign Indians, that notice by  
such person be forthwith given to his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> the Gov<sup>r</sup> and to  
the Colonel of that County where such Indians are discovered  
who is to Raise such force as he shall see necessary.

This Ord<sup>r</sup> to be made publick by the Sherriffs of the s<sup>d</sup> Coun-  
ties and copy thereof given to the Colonels of the same.

also pleased to write a L<sup>re</sup> to the Govern<sup>r</sup> of Carolina there-
