According to an Ord^r of yo^r Ex^{ncy} to Thomas Roberts to be Leivten^t under the Conduct of John Oldton by your Ex^{ncy} appointed Cap^t of the Rangers of Baltemore County: the motives and Reasons which Yo^r Ex^{ncy} Requires to the s^d Ord^r are as thus.

That the s^d Thomas Roberts is altogether incapable of the managemen of the s^d Office, and that the persons that are under my Conduct say, that they will not be Commanded by Whitehall the s^d Thomas Roberts, he being by them taken to be a moross sort of a Person and altogether unwilling to be by him Comanded. These Reasons and Objections I hope may weigh with your Ex^{ncy} and therefore I humbly Pray the Liberty of the Choice of Tobias Stanborough to be my Leivt^{nt} which doubt not but your Ex^{ncy} will admit off, when seen, being the needfull that Offers from.

Ordered that the hon^{rble} Coll: John Addison furnish Coll: Ninian Beal with as much Amunition as he finds he shall have Occasion for.

It being Ordered in Assembly that the Choptico and pomunky Indians &ca Should (dureing this time of warr) be Whitehall under the Emperor of Piscattoway;

Ordered that a Commission pursuant thereto be prepared to pass the Broad Seal.
