 Waters bond for procuring the portu-
 gueez boy &ca

Waters of Somerset County in the s^d province of
 Maryland Marriner and Arthur Denwood of the
 County and Province afores^d planter are holden and
 firmly bounden unto Maj^r Thomas Ennalls of Dor-
 chester County Merch^t in the full and Just Sume of two hun-
 dred pounds Sterl Current and lawfull money of and in Eng-
 land to be paid Convenient unto the s^d major Ennalls his heirs
 Executo^{rs} Adm^{rs} or Assignes To which paym^t well & truly to
 be made We bind Us or Either of us, our heirs or Either of
 them Joyntly or severally firmly In Witness whereof we have
 hereunto set our hand and Seals this Seventeenth day of July
 Anno Domini 1696. The Condition of this Obligation is such
 that if the above bounden Jeremi: Waters doth procure a
 Portugueez boy from Carolina and the same bring into this
 province & deliver him with all expedition to the s^d Maj^r
 Ennalls in Ord^r to his passage home to the Madera's as in a
 Speciall Warr^t Signed by his Ex^{ncy} ffrancis Nicholson Govern^r
 of this his Ma^{ty} province is expressed, & also save the s^d
 Ennalls & his Correspondents in the Madera's harmless and
 indemnified that then this Obligation to be Void & of none
 Effect otherwise to be in full force strength and Vertue.

 boroughs in- June last there Came a certain Sloope or Vessell
 formation from Philadelphia into the Inlet upon the Sea Side
 touching illegall in Somerset County which (as this Informant being
 Trade used at the Inlet in Somerset County. Credibly told) having her loading of Tob^o Provision
 and other Goods ready provided for her, tooke the
 Same on board and went away therewith without
 Entring or Clearing. Matth: Scarborough
