The s<sup>d</sup> Denton further moves and humbly Represents that having Severall ffes due to him as Clerk of a Speciall Court of Review appointed for the deciding a certain Controversy depending betwixt one George Lingan and Jam<sup>s</sup> Crawford the setlem<sup>t</sup> whereof were by an Ord<sup>r</sup> of this Board Suspended, untill the same should be settled by Act; And he Signifying that the Clerk of the Councill ffes being now Settled by an Act of Assembly of this Province does therefore Pray that the ffes due as Clerk of the s<sup>d</sup> Speciall Court may be now Assessed.
