Dan^{ll} Peirce Know all men by these p^rsents that We Dan^{ll} Peirce of Cæcill County in the province afores^d Gent of his Riding and Will^m Peirce Sen^r are holden & firmly bound^t unto his Ex^{ncy} ffrancis Nicholson Esq his Ma^{ty} Cap^t Gen^{ll} and Cheif Govern^r of this province in the full and Just Sum^e of One Thousand pounds of lawfull money of England to be paid to the said ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r his Ex^{ty} Adm^{ty} or assignes, To the w^{ch} paym^t well and truly to be made We bind our Selves and either of Us our and Either of our heirs Ex^{ty} & Adm^{ty} joyntly and Severally for the whole and in the whole firmly by these p^rsents, Witness our hands and Seals this 8th day of March 1695/6.

The Condition of the above written Obligation is such that whereas his Ex^{ncy} ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r afores^d hath Commissionated and appointed the s^d Dan^{ll} Peirce to be Riding Surveyo^r for Cæcill County and the Counties thereunto adjacent within the s^d province by his Commission bearing date, the 5th day of March 1695. Now if the s^d Dan^{ll} Peirce shall well and truly perform the s^d Office according to the severall Acts of Parliam^t and Laws of this province unto which by his s^d Commission he is Referred to be Guided by; as also shall observe and follow all such further directions and Instructions as from time to time he shall Receive from the s^d ffrancis Nicholson Esq and from time to time keep harmless the s^d ffrancis Nicholson Esq from all Damages loss & Charges that he the s^d ffrancis Nicholson Esq shall sustain at any time by Reason of the s^d Peirce non performance of his s^d Office (so long as he shall Enjoy the Same) as in the s^d Severall Laws is Enacted & Ordained. Then the above Obligation to be Void and of none Effect, otherwise to be and Remain in full force and Vertue.
