Delivered also by his Ex^{ncy} unto the s^d M^r Plater a L^{re} by him Rec^d from M^r John Bateman of Londⁿ Dated the 10th of Jan^{ry} last past relating to Cap^t Hurle & the ffrench Prize by him taken &c^a.

Delivered also at the Same time a Warr^t from the Com^{rs} for prizes for paymt of 10^{lb} p Gun (unto Cap^t John Hurle Commander of the Ship Providence) for every Gun the Ship John of Bourdeaux taken by the s^d Hurle was (at the time of her Capture) Mounted with.

Mr Plater Ordrd to make answer to Mr Batemans L^{re} &c^a

Ordered that he make Answer to the s^d Letter and Signifye th^t his Ex^{ncy} the Govern^r has Rec^d no Command neither from his Ma^{ty} nor the Lords of the Admiralty thereabout nor has medled with any of the Money; But if the Said Commissioners, have any Such Power in this place that they would do well to Send an Exemplification thereof and appoint an Officer here to manage that Concern.

Mr Clarke Ordered to deliver up unto Mr Plater all navigac^on Bonds &c^a

Ordered that M^r Philip Clarke Navall Officer of Potomock District deliver unto Geo: Plater Esq his Ma^{ts} Receiver Gen^{ll} all Navigation Bonds (now in his Custody) upon the s^d M^r Plater giving Receipt for the Same, and th^t such as have not been duly complied with, be by him put in Suit forthwith. p. 388
