Lords Jus-Whereas we formerly received Information from tices Proclathe Govern and Company of Merchants of London mation for apprehend-Trading to the East Indies, That one Henry Every, ing Capt Commander of the Ship called the Phansie alias Every & other Pyrats Charles, of fforty Six Guns, and one hundred and thirty men, had, und English Colours, committed Severall Acts of Piracy upon the Seas of India or Persia, Whereupon we issued a Proclamation, bearing date the 17th day of July last, for the taking and apprehending the sd Henry Every, and such other persons as were with him in the sd
