The Condition of the above Obligation is such that Whereas the above bound George Muschamp Esq^r is by his Ma^{ty} Royall Commission, bearing Date the Eighth day of October Anno 1695, Constituted and appointed Receiver of his Ma^{ty} Revenue Raised or to be Raised for the Support of Governm^t within the Precinct of the River of Potomock &c^{ca} as by Recourse to the s^d Commission, being had, more fully and at large doth appear; Now if the s^d George Muschamp shall and doe in all things well & ffaithfully discharge and perform that Trust as by the s^d Commission is reposed in him, as also produce and Render before his Ex^{ncy} in Councill a true & perfect Acco^t (twice every year) of all Sum^e & Sum^{es} of money or otherwise as shall by him be Collected for the Vse of his Ma^{ty} within the District or precinct afores^d from time to time and accordingly make Oath to the Same, during the continuance of his s^d Commission, then this present Obligation to be Void and of none Effect, otherwise to Stand and Remain in full force power and Virtue.

Whereas we formerly received Information from the Govern^r and Company of Merchants of London Trading to the East Indies, That one Henry Every, Commander of the Ship called the Phansie alias Charles, of fforty Six Guns, and one hundred and thirty men, had, und^r English Colours, committed Severall Acts of Piracy upon the Seas of India or Persia, Whereupon we issued a Proclamation, bearing date the 17th day of July last, for the taking and apprehending the s^d Henry Every, and such other persons as were with him in the s^d
