 And we do hereby further declare, That in Case any of the
 Persons above Named (except the s^d Henry Every alias Bridg-
 man) or any other persons who were in the s^d Ship with the
 s^d Henry Every alias Bridgman shall discover the said Henry
 Every alias Bridgman or any other of the persons above
 Named, so as they may be Seized and taken, in Order to be
 brought to Justice, he and they making such discovery shall
 p. 90 have his Ma^{ty} Gracious pardon for their Offences, And we do
 hereby further declare, That such person or persons, or any
 other person or persons who shall discover the s^d Henry
 Every alias Bridgman, so as he may be Seized or taken or
 Shall be otherwise Instrumentall in Seizing the s^d Henry
 Every als. Bridgman, so as he may be Seized or taken, he or
 they making such discovery or Seizure, shall have the Reward
 of ffive hundred Pounds promised in the s^d former Proclama-
 tion, for the Discovery and Seizure of the s^d Henry Every,
 And that in Case any person or persons shall discover of the
 other persons above Named, so as they may be Seiz'd or
 taken, or shall be otherwise Instrumentall in Seizing any of
 the s^d persons, he or they making such discovery or Seizure,
 shall have a Reward of ffifty pounds for every of the s^d per-
 sons, whom he or they shall so discover or Seize, w^{ch} s^d Severall
 Sum^s of ffive hundred pounds and ffifty pounds, the Lords
 Comm^{rs} of his Ma^{ty} Treasury are hereby Required and directed
 to pay accordingly; Given at the Councill Chamber in White-
 hall, the Tenth day of August 1696. In the Eighth year of
 his Ma^{ty} Reign.
