Ordr abt Mr Collyers paymt of 20: odd thousand pounds of Tobo to Mr Marsham Came M<sup>r</sup> Richard Marsham of Calvert County and humbly moves this hon<sup>rb</sup>le Board, that having obtain'd Judgm<sup>t</sup> against M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Collyer in the Prov<sup>ll</sup> Court of this Province, some time last Summer for 20: odd thousand pounds of Tobacco but the s<sup>d</sup> Collyer acting at p<sup>resent</sup> by Commission under his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> does Pray an Ord<sup>r</sup> of this Board that Execution may issue ag<sup>t</sup> him upon the s<sup>d</sup> Judgment whereby he may be Enabled to Get Satisfaction for his s<sup>d</sup> Debt; Ordered thereupon as it is hereby Ordered that the Petition<sup>r</sup> send to the s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Collyer about it, and if in Case he Neglects or Refuses to make Speedy Compliance therein, his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> will upon Notice thereof displace him and leave him open to the Law.
