Lastly his Exney is pleased to declare that he shall take it as a particular kindness from any person that shall in a Modest and Dutifull manner truly inform him how the Glory of God, his Mats Service and Good of the Countrey may be better promoted and how any of these are neglected, and does further Command all proons whatsoever to doe the Same.
