Ordered therevpon as it is hereby Ordered that the said Johnson still Remaine in the Custody of the Sherriffe, Untill he Give Good & sufficient Security or Enter into Recognizance himselfe in the Sumē of ffive hundred Pounds sterling, and his Two security in the Sumē of Two hundred & ffifty Pounds sterling each for his Appearance at the next Provinciaill Court to Answer the same & in the meane time to be of good behaviour.
