Ordered that Cap^t John Addison of Charles County and that Cap^t Thomas Holliday of Calvert County have hereby full Power to Examine the Widow of James Lysle as Evidence ag^t the Anacostin King, suspected to be concerned in the Murthering her husband ; as likewise all other Evidence or Evidences which shall be produced before them in that behalfe.

Vpon Representation of the Comissary Gen^{ll} of this Province; Ordered that the Justices & Comissioners of the severall & respective Counties within the same doe immediately vpon sight hereof direct & Order the severall Clerks belonging to their Courts to inspect and Examine their Records & Papers for all Testamentary Proceedings in their severall Courts taken & had, dureing the time of the Revolution and that the severall Records & papers touching Probat of Wills &c^a they cause, (with all possible expedition) to be duely & carefully returned (if such Records lay not intermixed with Business of another nature, in which case true Coppyes of the same are to be transmitted, Attested Under the s^d Clerks hands & County
