Officers Civill & Military continued by Proclamation His Ex^{ncie} was pleased, by advice of the Council, to Order that, vpon his Accession to the Governm^t Proclamation should issue for the continueng of all Officers & Ministers Civill & Military within this Province in their respective stations, Officers & places till further Orders, and requiring them accordingly to execute & performe their Duties therein.
