Gentlemen of the General Assembly.

The Council and I finding that we were not likely to pay the Debt due from the State to Mr Harrison by Remittances of Tobacco, in a reasonable Time, nor without very great Loss to the Public, purchased Bills of Exchange on France for that Purpose at the Rate of five, in Dollars at seven Shillings and six Pence, for one Sterling. The Schooner Gen' Smallwood which has made two Voyages to Martinique is of Course of little Use to the State; having mentioned our Inclination to sell her, Several Gentlemen have expressed their Desire of becoming Purchasers and at least £3200 might be got for her. I have inclosed her Inventory as given in by the Captain who lately sailed in her and the Council and I request your Advice whether an immediate Sale of her at Vendue might not be proper.
