the nine Months Men who inlist for three years, or during the C. C. War. It was late before this Resolution and Bill passed, they having been finished the other Day, but the Resolution strongly shews the Sense the Assembly have of the Services of the Officers. We shall send the Money with what Blankets we have and some other Cloathing to Philadelphia to be lodged in the Hands of our Delegates there, where we expect you will send a proper Person to receive it and from whence you will contrive to remove the Money and Cloathing in Safety.
