We have been induced to desire you to take Care of and deliver the Money to Gen<sup>1</sup> Smallwood from Cap<sup>t</sup> Landsdales informing us you have the Command of a Party of the Maryland Troops who are to go to the Jersies and join the other Maryland Troops there, and are very glad so favourable an Opportunity has presented.

We have also directed 100 Pair of Shoes and 100 Pair of Stockings to be sent you for your Men, which we expect you'll receive about the Time of your receiving this; we could not furnish Shirts.
