## In Council Annapolis 4th Feby 1779

Sir.

A Privateer from New York a few Days ago, took a Vessel from S<sup>t</sup> Eustatia, bound and belonging to Virginia; the Captors immediately manned her and, far within the Cape she attacked Cap<sup>t</sup> Sanders in a Sloop, a private armed Vessel owned in this State; Cap<sup>t</sup> Sanders proved too hard for the Assailants and retook the Virginian; we have ordered the Prize Master or Captain, one Frazier to Philadel<sup>a</sup> with Intention that he should be exchanged for Cap<sup>t</sup> Alexander Murray who was taken in Novem<sup>r</sup> in the Brig Saratoga, owned in this State, by the Unicorn Frigate, and has been permitted to come out of New York on Parole. We apprehend there can be no Objection to the Exchange; we have desired and shall be obliged to you for having it effected as soon as may be.
