In Council Annapolis 21st May 1779

Sir.

Be pleased to send us, as soon as you can, an exact Account of your Purchase and where it lies, as we may be able to make our general Return as desired; at farthest by the first of next Month; we expect to furnish you with the Money in three or four Days. We believe you may ^{p. 260} venture to close your Purchase immediately, as our Affairs are in such a Situation as to render our procuring the Quantity desired beyond a Doubt
