It is very difficult to get you any Thing from hence for Want of Carriage. We inclose you an Order on Col<sup>o</sup> Barnes for 100<sup>lbs</sup> of Powder which you'll make use of, if you should want, he has more than he'll have Occasion for. If the Enemy should come up the Bay, we imagine Baltimore & this Place will most likely be visited by them; we have applied what Arms we had, by much too few, with that View, but we hope to be able to strenghen you a little soon in Musquets.
