Gent.

In Consequence of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Gov<sup>r</sup> Morris's & your Letters,  
received by this Day's Post, we have directed Sam<sup>l</sup> Gilpin, Jn<sup>o</sup>  
Ward Veazey and Col<sup>o</sup> Henry Hollingsworth to deliver to the  
Issuing Commissary at the Head of Elk, what Flour they have  
in there Hands; it is all convenient and we believe, some of it  
on its Way to Philadelphia & a small Quantity of it at Philad<sup>a</sup>  
sent thither before the Orders to lodge it at Landings on this  
Bay. Their Quantities may probably amount to 3000 Barr<sup>ls</sup>  
We have also desired Col<sup>o</sup> Richard Dallam to send to the  
Issuing Commissary at the Head of Elk, from 12 to 1500  
Barr<sup>ls</sup> of the most convenient of his Flour, to be forwarded to  
Philadelphia.

In Council Annapolis 11<sup>th</sup> June 1779

By a Letter rec<sup>d</sup> by this Day's Post from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Gov<sup>r</sup>  
Morris, a Part of the Flour purchased in this State is desired  
to be delivered to the Order of the Commissary Gen<sup>l</sup> Mess<sup>rs</sup>  
Chaloner & White A. C. of P. who inclosed the Letter, desire  
it may be sent forward to Philad<sup>a</sup> with all possible Expedition,  
or that it might be ordered to the Care of the Commissary of  
Issues at Elk or Philad<sup>a</sup> We therefore request that you'll  
deliver to the Commissary of Issues residing at Elk, all the  
Flour which remains in your Hands of the Purchase of this  
State; if any of it is at Philadelphia or on its way thither under  
any of our Former Orders, so much the better. We  
hope the Commissary at Elk will exert himself to get the Flour  
to Philad<sup>a</sup> with all possible Dispatch and we shall be obliged  
to you to give him all the Assistance in your Power. If any  
Difficulty should arise about the Receipt of the Flour, we wish  
it not to be delayed 'til you can hear again from us, but desire
