We just now received a Letter from the Honble Gov^r Morris Esq^r desiring that 5000 of the 10000 Barrls of Flour purchased by this State, may be forwarded to William Smith Esq^r of Baltimore; we therefore request that you will forward all the Flour purchased under your Appointment now in your Hands with proper Invoices to Baltimore, addressed to M^r Smith and that you will finish this Business as quick as possible and make a final Settlement of your Accounts, that we may be able to settle a General Account with the Congress, it is the more necessary, as the State is like to be considerably in Advance 'til that is done.

W.
