That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Nathan Williams of the 6th Regim^t two thousand Dollars in leiw of the Articles for the present year allowed by the late Act of Ass^y

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Wallace Esq^r Paymaster one thousand five hundred Pounds on Account.
