We will send you up Cloathing for the Few Men at Baltimore by the first good Opportunity. We approve the Appointment of Swan and desire him to continue 'til contrary Orders. We shall return the Flour to Mr Buchanan as well as any Thing else of the Kindhe may lend you. It does not appear to us to be worth While to go into an Appointment of Officers, unless the Assembly should think proper to raise Companies, especially as a little Time will probably disclose the Necessity or Uselessness of Companies, nor indeed, do we know at present, where we could get proper Officers
