House adjourned 2 hours. Post Merediem house mett, and called over. Mr Harris and the rest of the gentlemen appointed to conferr with the honble Councill about the Bill for appointing Court days, Reporte to the house that the amendment proposed in the bill appointing court days is that Augt Court should be left out and that the County Courts should be held in ffebruary and March yearly.

Resolved that it be an Instruction to the said Gent of the said Conference not to consent to any further alteration in the said Bill, then the incerting the words to his most Sacred Maty:

The house adjourned till to morrow morning at 7 Clock, to M^r Speakers Chamber.

House mett, and called over, then read over what was done Yesterday. Resolved the following message be sent to his Excy and his Matys honble Councill.

By the house of Delegates March the 25th 1698.

We have recd your Excy answer to our address in relation to his Matys Lawyers, wherein your Excy seems to reflect as if this house was partiall in representing the Grievances of this province, when att the same time your Excy is sencible that a Bill is passed by this house to prevent that grievance you make mention of in your answer as for his Maty's prerogative we hope we shall have the same regard att all times as we p. 186 hope for our own rights and priviledges, we were in great hopes to have had a more Satisfactory answer from your Exey upon so great an infringemt upon our rights and Libertyes. But we have done our dutyes in representing the same to your Excy and shall proceed no further then by leaving our vote upon our Iournall to assert that Right and Liberty which before this time was never Questioned from the very first seating and Inhabiting of this province. as to your Excy demand whether all the members were privy and consenting to our address is so unparliamentary that we must beg your Excy to excuse our not answering.
