The Message Yesterday sent by the hon^{ble} Thomas Tench p. 70
Esq^r and Col Iohn Addison in relation to Col Ninian Beal has been here read and Considered and in respect of the good Services th^t the said Col Beal had done for this province and his willingness now in his old Age to Continue in the Service of this Country have resolved that M^r William Hutchinson buy and deliver unto the said Ninian Beal three negros and that the said three negros shall be Invested in the said Beal dureing his Naturall life and after dureing the naturall life of his wife and after to such Child or Children as he shall by his last Will and Testam^t dispose of them to, And that M^r Hutchinson have power to draw upon the Treasurer of the Westerne shoar for the Sum of Seaventy five pounds for the paym^t of the Same and that the said Negros for any Debt or Iudgem^t whatsoever due from or recovered ag^t the said Ninian Beal shall not be taken in Execution for the Satisfaction of any Such Debt or Iudgem^t
