Ord^d that the same be referd to the Comittee of Laws Proposed by a member of this house whither the three pence p^r hhd since his p^rsent Ex^{cy} accession to this Gou^rnm^t does now by any Law belong to this p^rsent Gov^r if not that a Bill be prepared to Invest it him

Resolved th^t a Bill be prepared to Invest the three pence p^r hhd in his p^rsent Ex^{cy} Nathaniell Blakistone that has accrewed since his Ex^{cy} has taken this Gourenm^t upon him
